PUT YOUR OLD CELL PHONE TO GOOD USE To Help Save Lives

The Interagency Committee of State-Employed Women (ICSEW) conducts an **on-going “recycle your personal cell phone with rechargeable battery and cords” drive**. Cell phones donated to ICSEW are delivered to Human Response Network; which is a non-profit organization committed to combating domestic violence, providing emergency relief, and supporting health and education initiatives. Human Response Network services include SafeHaven – Emergency Shelter, safety planning, advocacy based counseling, support groups, legal advocacy, resource and referral and community education. Their services are open to women, men, teens, children and the elderly.

Human Response Network distributes donated cell phones to domestic violence victims for 911 services only. All personal information is deleted from the donated cell phones.

Your old cell phones along with the necessary batteries, cords and any accessories may be sent to the attention of Sherry Hickam at the Office of the Attorney General – Social and Health Services Division, Olympia.

Your donation may be self-reported to the IRS. If you would like a receipt, please send a note along with your donated cell phone and a receipt will be sent to you.
