This policy describes the duties of the Public Outreach subcommittee. This policy is intended to provide guidance and expectations of the Public Outreach subcommittee.

SCOPE

This policy applies to members on the Public Outreach subcommittee.

POLICY

The Public Outreach subcommittee will be responsible to:

- Build partnerships within the community.
- Sponsor professional clothing and toiletry drives, along with other various collections throughout the year including organizing, collecting, and coordinating drop-off of donations.
- Collaborate with local organizations to influence positive change on the citizens of Washington.
- Promote awareness of the needs and opportunities to help women in state government and our community.
- Support all the other subcommittees in hosting their events, including the Conference subcommittee's annual leadership conference.
- Maintain promotional material, maintain inventory of items, and make recommendations when items are needed.
- Highlight events, non-profits, and personal and professional development opportunities using social media, website, and LISTSERV.
- Coordinate and promote professional clothing and toiletry drives, along with other various collections statewide.
- Reserve and staff a table at public events to promote ICSEW.
- Identify local non-profits with volunteer opportunities that support the mission of ICSEW.
