# **ICSEW Appoints Josefina Magaña as New Executive Chair**

**OLYMPIA**—The <u>Interagency Committee of State Employed Women, ICSEW</u>, is pleased to announce Josefina Magaña has been appointed to committee chair, effective January 2, 2021.

Magaña is an administrative regulations analyst for the <u>Department of Labor and Industries</u> where she manages safety and health projects. She has served on ICSEW since 2017. She most recently served as the committee's vice chair aiding in the transition of new leadership. Magaña previously served as the ICSEW's Mentorship Subcommittee Chair, where she worked with a group of subcommittee members to launch the ICSEW's mentorship pilot program.
