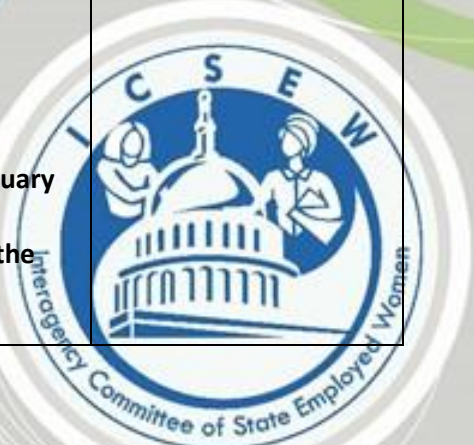

<p>11:15-11:40</p>	<p><b>NoProblem.Period</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Provide menstrual hygiene product bins for the Rochester, WA high school bathrooms</li> <li>• Bins include pads, tampons, pantyliners, wipes, underwear, and leggings all at no cost to the student</li> <li>• Noproblem.period has found that providing these items to students reduces the number of days of school missed due to having your period and eliminates barriers for those who cannot afford these products</li> <li>• During COVID Izzy and Audrey did doorstep delivery for the entire community</li> <li>• HB 1273 will mandate that by the beginning of the 2022-23 school year, every school district make menstrual hygiene products available to students at no cost.
