- September 17th from 1-3 is the next Board meeting (with the General Meeting in the morning)
- For the General Meeting, in the last hour, we'll have subcommittee break out rooms where people can learn about the 4 subcommittees
- Discussed whether or not special projects should also present? Also does this need to be a subcommittee of its own?
  - Answer: special projects will present. They will not be a subcommittee.
- The brochure for the conference is almost done, Connie will send to the Executive Secretaries and put in the Conference Folder when finished
- We have \$43,000 in sponsorships and \$58,000 in commitments for the Conference so far (I was a little confused on this, I'm assuming the \$43k nests inside the \$58k but not sure what the distinction between a sponsorship and commitment is)
